

Membership Requirements and Application (July 4th, 2005)

Membership Requirements per RTSA By-Laws, Article 3 – Membership

SECTION – 1 – ELIGIBILITY AND FORM OF APPLICATION:

Senior membership of this organization is limited to male citizens of the United States, 16 years of age or over, who are interested in sportsmanship of fishing and hunting, conservation of our natural resources, or any other form of outdoor related activities.

SECTION – 2 – JUNIOR MEMMBERSHIP:

Limited to male citizens between the ages of 12 and 16, sponsored by a senior member in good standing, subject to the rules. Sons of a member gets(sic) first chance to join the association.

SECTION – 3 – INITIATION FEES COVERING JUNIOR MEMBERS:

At 12 years of age pays \$1.00, when reaching 16 years of age pays nothing.

At 13 years of age pays \$1.00, when reaching 16 years of age pays \$20.00.

At 14 years of age pays \$1.00, when reaching 16 years of age pays \$30.00.

At 15 years of age pays \$1.00, when reaching 16 years of age pays \$40.00.

At 16 years of age pays \$50.00—becomes a senior member--

SECTION – 4 – PROSPECTIVE MEMBERS:

Must complete an application form and secure the signatures of two members in good standing. The application should be presented to the Board of Directors with \$50.00(sic) initiation fee and \$10.00 for one years(sic) dues.

SECTION – 5 – MANNER OF ELECTION TO THE ASSOCIATION:

The applicant must appear before the board of directors to answer any or all questions put to him. Then must be accepted by a majority of the directors present at the meeting(sic). If accepted the financial secretary will issue the new member a membership card at the next regular meeting.

SECTION – 6 – EXPLULSION OF MEMBERS:

Any member may be expelled from the association by $\frac{3}{4}$ vote of the membership at their regular meeting. Violation of the rules and regulations of the association, or otherwise disqualifying himself may be the reason of expulsion. Every member must be given an opportunity to defend himself in an open meeting before being expelled.

SECTION – 7 – DUES:

The annual dues of each active member shall be determined by the membership, payable in advance. The fiscal year shall be from September 1 to August 31. At the January regular meeting the grace period shall be terminated. Each member shall be liable for dues until his oral or written resignation is received by the financial secretary. After the grace period has expired a penalty will be levied.

SECTION – 8 – MEMBERS ON ACTIVE DUTY ONLY IN THE MILITARY FORCES:

They shall pay no dues. Upon completion of the first hitch a member has 90 days to pay his dues before he is terminated from the association. No member shall be carried for more than the first hitch.

SECTION – 9 – ANNUAL DUES OF JUNIOR MEMBERS:

Shall be determined by the membership payable in advance.

SECTION – 10 – PAYMENTS TO AFFILIATED MEMBERSHIPS:

The association dues or monies paid to the Allegheny County League(sic) shall be determined from time to time by a vote of the membership. The affiliation dues of the State Federation of Sportsmen's Club may be changed at the annual meeting of the State Federation Directors.
